The rules, regulations, bye-laws, orders, directives and procedures under the 1984 Electricity Law which is repealed by this law shall be in force to the extent that they are not contrary to the provisions ...

The permit holder to carry out importing, manufacturing and selling of electrical equipment shall abide by the specification of quality and standardizations of electrical equipment contained in the rules, ...

The Electricity Law of 2014 replaces the Electricity Law of 1984. The Law deals with the provision of access to electricity for the economic and social development of the country.

The Electricity Law (the 2014 Pyidaungsu Hluttaw Law No.44) was enacted in 2014 (Electricity Law). The Electricity Law creates the Electricity Regulatory Commission (ERC).
