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Should a server rack be a deep or a shallow rack?

For front to back airflow, deeper racks provide superior cable management and prevent cables from restricting airflow. If your servers exhaust heat from the sides, shallower racks may be adequate, but they compromise future scalability. Finally, plan ahead.

How deep are server rack cabinets?

Depth is the least standardized of the various server cabinets. Height can be in rack units (U) and width at 19 inches, but depth requires more precise attention. That's why it is so crucial to know about the standard server rack cabinets depth range.

How much clearance should a server rack have?

You should also keep at least a 3-foot clearance at the rear of the cabinet or rack to allow for service and maintenance. There are no side clearance requirements for the cabinets or racks due to the front to back airflow of the servers.

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It is 1200 millimeters deep and supports mounting of equipment up to 1050 millimeters deep. This allows high-density equipment installations, extra space for cable management, and room for removing hot ...

Server racks should be 600mm (24 in) wide by 1200 mm (47.2 in) deep to accommodate deeper servers and provide room for cable management at the back of the rack.

The standard depth for a rack enclosure is around 39 inches / 1000mm, but you can get extra-deep (48 inches / 1200mm) rack enclosures for deeper servers and blade chassis.
