The periodic switching of the load voltage between $+V_{dc}$ and $-V_{dc}$ produces a square wave voltage across the load. Although this alternating output is nonsinusoidal, it may be an adequate ac ...

It contains two switches and each of its capacitors has a voltage output equal to $V_{dc}/2$. In addition, the switches complement each other, that is, if one is switched ON the other one goes OFF.

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
