Electricity generation in Venezuela has been on a mostly downward trend since 2013, when it reached the peak of the decade, at 132.6 terawatt-hours.

By embracing a mixture of both solar and nuclear energy, Venezuela can diversify its energy sources, reduce reliance on fossil fuels, and strengthen its clean energy sector to meet future demands.

Besides hydroelectric power, Venezuela also relies on natural gas and petroleum, contributing 25% and 11%, respectively, to the total electricity output that year.

But the electricity mix -- the balance of sources of electricity in the supply -- is becoming increasingly important as countries try to shift away from fossil fuels towards low-carbon sources of electricity ...

Despite possessing one of the world's largest oil reserves, Venezuela operates a centralized electrical system
