What is the capital of Djibouti Telecom?

The Djibouti Telecom headquarters is located in Djibouti City. General assessment: Telephone facilities in the city of Djibouti are defined by CIA World Factbook as "adequate as are the microwave radio relay connections to outlying areas of the country." Radio broadcast stations: AM 1, FM 2, shortwave 0 (2001)

Does Djibouti have any radio stations?

Maintains restrictions on the licensing and operation of broadcast media; state-owned Radiodiffusion-Television de Djibouti (RTD) operates the only 2 domestic radio networks. No private TV or radio stations are allowed (2007).

Is Djibouti Telecom building a new cable landing station?

Djibouti Telecom has begun construction on a new Cable Landing Station in Djibouti City. The CLS will consist of three floors, with each floor having a 250 square meter (2,690 sq ft) equipment room. The 3rd floor is reportedly reserved for colocation. The facility is expected to be completed by April 2022.

Is Djibouti Telecom creating a digital platform?

Djibouti Telecom, under the direction of its Director General Mohamed Assoweh Bouh, is building a digital platform for the region. Wingu.Africa has partnered with Djibouti ISP TO7 Network to develop a carrier-neutral data center and carrier-neutral cable landing station.
