A3. Yes. Generally, to claim a refund, a taxpayer must file an amended return within 3 years after the date the original return was filed, or 2 years after the date the tax was paid, whichever is later. For ...

A solar PV system does not necessarily have to be connected to the electric grid for you to claim the residential federal solar tax credit, as long as it is generating electricity for use at your residence.

Not Refundable: If your total tax liability is less than the credit amount, the unused portion is not refunded as cash. Instead, it may be carried forward to offset taxes in subsequent years, ...

The credit is nonrefundable, so the credit amount you receive can't exceed the amount you owe in tax. You can carry forward any excess unused credit, though, and apply it to reduce the tax you owe in ...
